#### **Distribution and demographic analysis of *Crepis granatensis* (Willk.) Blanca & Cueto (Compositae)**

*Crepis granatensis* (Willk.) Blanca & Cueto (Compositae) is a small endemic hemicryptophyte. Its habitat is restricted to some few mountainous massifs from the south of the Iberian Peninsula between 1700 and 2000 m high, on mobile limestones. This plant is included as Endangered in the Red List of Spanish Vascular Flora and in the Red Book of the Threatened Wild Flora of Andalusia. This work is based on herbariums information, bibliographic revisions and field work. This plant is recently presumed extinct from some mountainous massifs, and it is only locally abundant in Sierra Mágina. A monitoring of the populations actually known is being performed, and the first data are provided in this work. These data show a continuous decrease in the number of reproductives.
